




2 – Cooling Fans with Wire Grills









## KIT, DUAL FAN, CUBE-IT

#### Assembly Sequence

- 1. Attach Power Cord connector and green ground wire to one of the two fans. Use supplied M4 screw to secure green ground wire loop to the fan body. Connect power cord extension to second fan.
- 2. It is recommended to mount both fans in the lower vent patterns, directly opposite each other, on the right and left sides of the cabinet. Using the included screws, attach Fans and Mounting Plates to the cabinet as shown (note Mounting Plate orientation). Fans should be inside the cabinet with the Mounting Plate between the fan and cabinet.
- 3. Route power cords and secure where needed.
- 4. From outside the cabinet, snap the Plastic Retainers to the Mounting Plates, capturing the Filter media.
- 5. Plug Power Cord into approved power supply to power fans. Fans will run when powered.
