100% Employee-Owned

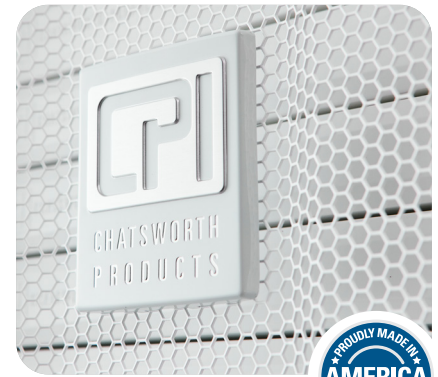

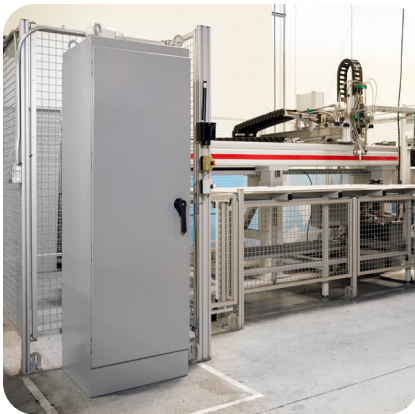

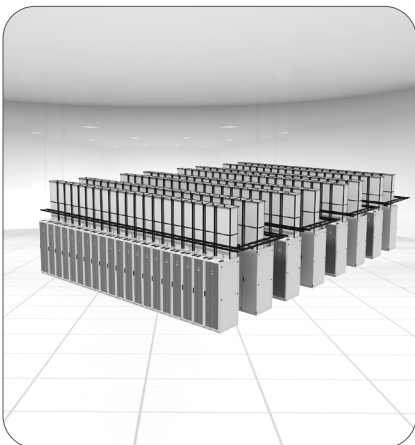
